Homestead Exemption Filing Season – Now through March 1, 2019

- OCPA hosts Satellite Offices throughout Orange County to assist property owners -

Orlando, FL – The [Orange County Property Appraiser's Office](#) will staff Satellite Offices throughout Orange County during January and February to assist property owners in completing the filing process for homestead and other exemptions. Representatives from the main downtown office will be in neighborhood locations and available to answer questions about the following [property based tax exemptions](#): Homestead, Widow/Widower, Military and Disabled Veterans, Limited Income Senior and Trust documentation, and more.

“These are important, tax-saving instruments and we want to do everything we can to ensure that property owners file for their exemptions in a timely manner,” said [Rick Singh, CFA, Orange County Property Appraiser](#). “To make it easier for our constituents to obtain assistance, we are reaching out to the community by setting up offices in their neighborhoods.”

Applications for exemptions can be filed [online](#), by [mail](#), or in person. To file in person, homeowners may visit the [downtown Orlando office](#) or one of the [Satellite Offices](#).

“The important thing to remember is the deadline, added Singh. “Homeowners must file before March 1, and my team and I stand ready to help our constituents file by the March 1 deadline.”
