The 3rd annual tree seedling giveaway on Wall Street in Downtown Orlando brings attention to the positive impact of reforestation, and offers an opportunity for residents to meet OCPA staff and learn more about exemptions and other property-related issues.

“This annual event helps our community plant new life at their homes, or businesses,” Singh said. “Make plans now to join us ... 500 trees seedlings will go quickly!”

In addition to the tree seedling giveaway, the Property Appraiser's office has launched a variety of green initiatives under Rick Singh's leadership. In 2015, to cut down on emissions, the office unveiled 30 hybrid vehicles for field staff to use for appraisals. Another initiative cuts out cars all together by offering a commuter benefit to all employees who take an alternate method of travel into work each day.
