



Exemption Filing by Email or Mail

Homestead and Additional Exemptions

We are pleased to offer you the convenience of filing by mail for your Homestead exemption. To complete an application for Homestead exemption, you must **own and occupy** your home prior to **January 1st** of the year in which you are eligible to apply. We are currently accepting timely 2021 exemption applications. The deadline to file is **March 1, 2021**.

Follow these steps to file by email or mail.

Step 1 - Print the application form and instructions.

Step 2 - Review the requirements listed below in this section and obtain the appropriate documents such as deed, driver's license, etc.

- For each applicant, provide two of the following proofs of residency, one of which **must include a Florida Driver's License**, or must include a Florida Identification Card if a non-driver.
 - Florida Driver's License (Required)
 - Identification Card (Required if non-driver)
 - Vehicle registration
 - Voter registration
 - [Declaration of Domicile](#) (if you do not have a second form of ID. Must be recorded at the Comptroller's Office prior to submission)

Step 3 - Once completed, submit your application by **March 1st**. You can email your application and supporting documentation to customerservice@ocpafl.org.
